Women Writers



Women Writers is a broad topic that includes works written by and about women authors. Search the CGCC Library Catalog (<http://www.cgc.maricopa.edu/library>) or periodical indexes (Infotrac and EBSCOHost) to find information on specific authors and their writings. Look under the author's name as the SUBJECT to find information about the author. Look under the author's name as AUTHOR to find material written by the author. The sources listed here are only a **selected** list of many that are available; search the CGC Library Catalog to find other resources.
