



TEAL & SILVER AWARDS 2008

PURPOSE

The Chandler-Gilbert Community College (CGCC) Teal & Silver Awards Program was created to recognize the contributions of individuals (non-employees) who support CGCC students, employees, programs, services, and the college community.

The college collaborates with community and school partners to serve our students and we rely on community support to achieve our goals. It is appropriate to recognize the contributions of our colleagues, partners, supporters, alumni, and community leaders in the success of our students.

AWARD CATEGORIES

Nominations are accepted in the following categories:

- ❖ **K-12 School Colleague**: An individual or group of people who have worked with the college to develop a program, support student service learning placements, advise and recruit students, or otherwise support the college.
- ❖ **University Colleague**: A person or group of people who have worked with the college to develop transfer programs, share resources, develop a program, provide a service, or otherwise support the college.
- ❖ **Community College Colleague**: A person or group of people from a sister Maricopa College, the Maricopa District Support Services Center, or another community college in Arizona or throughout the United States, who have collaborated on college programs, helped resolve issues, or otherwise support the college.
- ❖ **Business and Industry Partner**: An individual or organization who has made significant contributions to a program or service by way of making equipment donations, providing staffing support, hosting student or faculty/staff interns, providing student scholarships, or otherwise supporting the college.
- ❖ **Technology Partner**: An individual or organization who donates hardware or software, or provides hardware or software discounts, or offers specialized training, or otherwise makes a special effort to support college needs.
- ❖ **Community-Based Organization Partner**: An individual or organization who has collaborated with the college to provide service learning placements, internships, specialized services for our students, or other services to the college.
- ❖ **Scholarship Donor**: An individual or group who has provided significant student scholarships for several years.
- ❖ **Advisory Council Member**: An individual who has served on one of the many college advisory councils for at least two years and who has made a significant contribution to the program or to the college as a result of their service.

- ❖ Alumni: A CGCC alumni who continues to support college programs or services, or who by way of their position or achievements reflects well on the college.
- ❖ Community Leader: A community leader who has supported college programs, services, or issues in the community, or who has advocated publicly for college needs.

MAKING A NOMINATION

Nominations can be made by any CGCC employee, full-time or part-time, who has worked at the college for at least two years. Nominations must be supported by the vice president, provost, or administrator(s) with oversight for the area, service, or program to which the nominee has contributed. Nominations are due to the President's Office by Monday, March 3, 2008.

CRITERIA

These awards are presented annually to individuals who are not employed by CGCC in a full-time capacity and:

- ❖ Positively impact college students, employees, programs, or services
- ❖ Assist with program or service improvements
- ❖ Support creative and innovative ideas or program enhancements
- ❖ Help improve the quality of the college experience for our students
- ❖ Help support our employees in the delivery of instruction and services
- ❖ Provide resources, make a donation, or assist with cost-saving measures
- ❖ Advocate for the college in the media, with elected officials, and in the general community
- ❖ Reflect positively on the college
